I am absolutely delighted to have been elected as NNAC President. I consider it a great honour and I'm very mindful of following in the footsteps of the illustrious members who have previously held this office over the years. During my last seven years on the NNAC Council, I've been pleased to play a small part in the considerable "backstage" work that keeps the Circle thriving. Now I hope to support the new Council as it continues to manage the Circle's affairs. I was born and brought up in Lowestoft and regularly visited Norwich Castle Museum as a boy. I consider the Norwich School painters to have been a major influence on my interest in art - I wanted to draw like Henry Bright. I devoured Adrian Hill's "Sketch Club" on our black and white TV screen and learned from his books which I regularly borrowed from Lowestoft Library.

After a career in the performing arts, I returned seriously to drawing and painting in the late 1990s and have been a full-time, "jobbing" artist since 2007. Observational drawing is at the root of everything I do. I mostly paint landscapes and portraits or figures - preferring to work direct from the subject where possible. I demonstrate art materials and techniques to art societies and other groups and am a UK brand ambassador for Derwent pencils and for Pan Pastels and Daniel Smith paints. I am currently the Chair of the Harleston and Waveney Art Trail and I'm a member of several other art groups in the region and nationally - including being a Silver Signature member of the UK Colour Pencil Society. As President, I intend to fly the flag for NNAC and do what I can to help cement its place as one of the premier art societies in the UK.
