recorded what she saw there
in paint and words.

The exhibition shows some
paintings and also films of
Norfolk that she made. She
was also a wall artist record-
ing the destruction in Norwich
during the Second World
War. Her paintings are now in
the collection of the Castle
Museum.

As well as paintings and film,
the exhibition shows Some of
her very well painted
miniatures and models of
Norfolk buildings.

The exhibition continues all
summer.
