KEN HURST'S SOCIAL MEDIA TIPS

Even if you're not a fan of Face-
book, Twitter, Instagram and the
like, you can still help NNAC
(and yourself) by generating
some publicity around our up-
coming exhibition. For instance,
why not send an email to all
your friends, family and other
contacts.

And if getting that done sounds
like a pain, here are some tips.

What to say?

How about something like this
(in your own words of course)?
"Hi all, apologies for the round
robin email but I wanted to tell
everyone about a really exciting
exhibition (that I have a picture
in?).

I've attached a flyer that tells
you all about it (and an invitation
to the private view opening and/
or I'll be there on the xxth; why
not pop in and see me and have
a day at the seaside), etc, etc.

Who to send it to?

Here's a tip if you don't know it
already.

Put in your own address as the
main recipient then using the
bcc (blind carbon copy) address
line (so no-one can see your
address list) start by typing in
the letter A. All your contact with
a significant A in their name
should pop up as 'auto-fill' recip-
ient suggestions. Select the
ones you want to send the email
to. Then type B in and do the
same. And so on through the
alphabet.

Quite soon you'll then have a
list for promoting your art in the
future.
